Wounds, Injuries, Contusions, Burns, etc., to be filed according to causative agent under Nos. 166 to 189. File in Section under which organ belongs, but give Number from Traumatic Classification List, which see. (E. g., Lacerated wound of liver, if produced by a fall, assign "172, Lacerated wound of liver"; if from automobile or railroad accident, assign "175, Lacerated wound of liver"; etc.)

Assign any abscess or inflammatory process due to tuberculosis or gonococcus, etc., under that Number in Section I.

Diseases are numbered, first, according to Section; second, according to No. of disease in Section; and third, according to the International Classification. E. g., Scarlet Fever is numbered 1-10-7: 1, Section No.; 10, No. of disease in Section; and 7, International Classification No.
